Annual Men's Member – Guest Tournament

On behalf of the Dunedin Golf Club membership, the Board of Directors, our Management and the entire Dunedin Golf Club team, it is our pleasure to welcome you, your guest and your families to the Annual 2021 Men's Member-Guest Golf Tournament.

The Dunedin Golf Club members and team are happy to host this monumental tournament. The format for this year's event will be Net Best-Ball consisting of five nine-hole matches in which each team will have the opportunity to play all the other teams in their flight. As in years past, this format will increase both the competition and social interaction within the flights. All flights will be required to play three nine-hole matches on Friday. Saturday will consist of two nine-hole matches followed by a Shoot-out to determine the overall Tournament Champions.

Teams will be grouped in flights of 6. Participants will play at 80% of their USGA handicap, based on Dunedin Golf Club's White Tee rating. Each team will play five nine-hole matches. A maximum of twenty points will be awarded for each nine-hole match as follows:

- 2 points for winning the hole
- 1 point for tying the hole
- 2 points for winning the match
- 1 point for tying a match
- 0 points for losing the hole or match

A 4-hole shoot-out will be held between the flight winners on Saturday afternoon utilizing a format which brings added excitement, and anticipation to the determination of the "Overall Champions"

Throughout the weekend, all members, guests and their families are invited to use all of the Dunedin Golf Club's facilities. If there is anything, we can do to make your stay here at the Dunedin Golf Club more enjoyable, please do not hesitate to ask.

FORMAT

Teams will be flighted. Participants will play at 80% of their USGA handicap, based on Dunedin's 122 slope. Teams will be assigned to flights based on the combined tournament indexes of the member and his guest.

Each team will play five (5) nine-hole matches, 3 matches on Friday and 2 on Saturday. A maximum of twenty (20) points will be awarded for each nine-hole match as follows:

- 2 Points** for winning the hole
- 1 Point** for tying the hole
- 2 Points** for winning the match
- 1 Point** for tying the match
- 0 Points** for losing the hole or match

All matches should be played in their entirety (9 holes) since the overall point totals in all matches will determine the flight winners.

Teams will play four-ball match play. All participants will play off the low handicap in the match. Half strokes will be given when necessary. Half strokes are given when your handicap is an odd number (ie. a 3 handicap would receive 1 ½ shots per nine). Please see following example:

Player	Dunedin handicap	80% Dunedin handicap	Strokes
Player 1 Team A	25	20	12 (6 per nine)
Player 2 Team A	10	8	0
Player 1 Team B	20	16	8 (4 per nine)
Player 2 Team B	14	11	3 (1 ½ per nine)

**In the event of a “blind” team in your flight, your match against that team will be you and your partner “Playing Against PAR”. In the Best Ball format, you will need to score a “NET PAR” to tie the hole. Strokes will be given as they fall on the scorecard. **

At the completion of each match, scorecards must be signed and attested, then turned into the scoring committee located at the scoreboard. The card should reflect the points scored on each hole as well as total points received for the match. Scorecards for your next match will be issued at that time. Any discrepancies, or questions must be directed to our Director of Golf, John Falcone.

TOURNAMENT RULES

Times

Friday – Round 1 – 9:00 Shotgun
Friday – Round 2 – 11:30 Shotgun
Friday – Round 3 – 2:00 Shotgun

Saturday – Round 1 – 9:00 Shotgun
Saturday – Round 2 – 11:30 Shotgun
Saturday – Shootout – approx. 2:00

Doubt as to Procedure

If there is any doubt about procedure, or if a dispute arises, then a claim may be made. The players shall continue the match without delay. All claims must be made to opponents before any player in the match plays from the next teeing ground. Upon completion of the match, the claim will be considered by the Committee.

Cell Phones

The use of cell phones on the golf course during the play of a match will not be permitted. (Exceptions for emergency calls). Teams shall lose any hole where an infraction takes place. This decision will be made by the Tournament Committee.

Tie Breakers

In the event of a tie at the end of the matches, flight winners will be determined in the following manner:

1. Winner of the head-to-head match of tied teams
2. Total points scored starting with the 5th match, 4th match, etc.
3. If there is still a tie at the end of all five matches, cards will be matched sudden death starting on the #1 handicap hole of the fifth match and continuing by handicap hole until the tie is broken.

Prizes

“Overall Tournament Champions” will be determined by a Shoot-out consisting of all 8 flight winners following play on Saturday (see “Shoot-out” on p.6).
Tournament prizes will be presented to the first 2 teams in each flight.

Suspension / Rain-out

If play is suspended, it shall be resumed from where it was discontinued. When the suspension is called, you must mark your ball immediately and discontinue play. Play will resume when the Committee deems the conditions are appropriate and the course playable.

Should a round be cancelled, all points scored in that round will be cancelled. A “round” in this tournament consists of nine holes.

Rain-out scenarios:

Friday – Complete Rain-out:

The two matches from Saturday + the first originally scheduled match from Friday (3 total matches) will determine flight champions based on total points earned. If ties exist, we would match cards from the head to head match, if it occurred. If it did not occur or three teams tie, then a chip off will determine the winners. The Shoot-out will follow as scheduled.

Friday/Saturday – Partial Rain-out:

If one match is completed, match two and match three are eliminated. If two matches are completed, then the third match is eliminated.

Saturday – Complete Rain-out:

Friday’s points total will determine the flight winners. If ties exist, we will match cards from the head to head match if it occurred. If it did not occur, then the team who won the most points in round one will be declared the winners. If a tie still exists, then we will go back to round one scorecards and determine who won the most holes. The Overall Champions will be determined by the flight champions who won the most points over the three matches played on Friday. If a tie still exists, the most points in round one, followed by rounds two and three will be determined the Champions. If all matches are tied, the Overall Champions will be blind drawn.

SHOOT-OUT FORMAT

All 8 Flight Winners will play off for the OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP in an **alternate shot format**. The shoot-out will utilize holes #10, #14 #18 and conclude on #13. The 2 highest team scores will be eliminated each hole until two teams remain on #13. Each player will play from the same tees he played during the tournament. The team with the lowest score on the 13th hole will be the OVERALL CHAMPIONS. In the event of a tie on any hole, a chip-off will be used to determine the hole winner. In the chip-off, both players will chip from a predetermined location and the team with the shortest combined distance will move on to the next hole.

The starting order of play, off #10 will be determined by draw. Honor will decide the remaining orders. It is the team's choice as to who tees off on the first shoot-out hole (#10). If player A tees off on #10, then player B will tee off on #14, alternating until you finish.

Handicapping Example:

Teams will receive the combined average of their tournament handicaps divided by two (an average of the two players). Example: Player A has a 5 handicap, and his partner has a 12 handicap. The total team handicap is 17, divided by 2 = 8 ½. Half-strokes will be rounded up to the next number, 9 in this example. The team will receive strokes on the scorecard as they fall based on the 9 handicaps.

Hole #10 is the 10-handicap hole

Hole #13 is the 8-handicap hole

Hole #14 is the 6-handicap hole

Hole #18 is the 2-handicap hole

The team in this example would receive strokes on holes 13, 14 & 18 if they were to advance in the playoff.
